




Letter of Cooperation
between the
Briarbrook Brookside Morgan's Grant Community Association
and the
Ottawa Stewardship Council



1. This 'Letter of Cooperation' between the Briarbrook Brookside Morgan's Grant Community Association (BMGCA) and the Ottawa Stewardship Council (OSC) seeks to reaffirm their shared goals of advancing a community-based stewardship of the Kanata North (*formerly Morgan's Grant*) Hydro corridor based on the principles of creating an environmentally safe, healthy and sustainable urban green space accessible to people and nature.
2. The Kanata North Hydro corridor is an area of land owned and managed by the City of Ottawa and under lease to Hydro One, In this context, any community or individual activities carried out on the corridor must have prior agreement of the City and fall within the safety and access requirements of Hydro One.
3. As the community association representing the overall community, the BMGCA has a responsibility and interest to make information on the fair use of the corridor publicly available. Groups and individuals wishing to access the corridor will benefit from the BMGCA as a reliable source of information and as an important site through which they may gain access to and seek to cooperate with other community groups working to improve the corridor.
4. The OSC continues to cooperate with the BMGCA in advising and providing expertise on community stewardship, appropriate environmental and conservation activities, and training. It further seeks to support within the context of this letter, the offer of such support and advice to any other community groups wishing to participate in making the corridor a safer and more environmentally sustainable urban greenspace.
5. Although this 'Letter of Cooperation' has been established initially between the BMGCA and the OSC it is open to any other volunteer or community groups wishing to work cooperatively to help improve the Morgan's Grant Hydro corridor. Groups wishing to sign on will become part of an ever growing neighborhood of volunteers working together and in concert with the City of Ottawa to make the Kanata North Hydro Corridor an integral component of the City's expanding network of green spaces.
6. We are convinced that by working together we will create and maintain a safe, attractive and accessible urban greenspace through community stewardship in support of and working with the City of Ottawa.
